

## The Feng Shui Program

The courses in this stream are designed to give the student a solid foundation in both the ancient traditional and modern approaches to Feng Shui. Courses are based on the compass school of Feng Shui. The student develops the ability to work with residential and commercial environments. In the more advanced courses the student is taught to read the “energy print” of a space and explore the present and future possibilities it holds.

### Feng Shui Introductory

Understand the five elements, the eight trigrams and how they interact. We will cover various compass school formulas for charting a variety of home/business floor plans.

### Feng Shui Intermediate

Pre-requisite: Introductory Feng Shui

The intermediate level will focus on over 100 feng shui cures. Cures to counteract negative influences, as well as those to enhance specific goals (such as abundance, peace, career success). We will also explore Nine Star Astrology and The Four Pillars Of Destiny Astrology. Integration of knowledge will be emphasized through case studies of homes and businesses.

### Feng Shui Advanced

Pre-requisite: Intermediate Feng Shui

The advanced studies explore many of the inner mystical techniques of Feng Shui. The student is expected to practice various techniques to develop their ability to focus energy. Students will learn to clear and bless homes/businesses. Practical instruction is given regarding how to carry out a complete Feng Shui consultation with a client. Significant classroom time will be spent on case studies and working with actual home and work sites.
